Hernando County Government - On the Move!

Exciting changes are happening within Hernando County Government beginning next week. In a continuing effort to streamline services and reduce costs, several County Government offices will relocate within the next few months. As a result of these changes, the County will realize a significant savings by the discontinuation of lease payments.

Two offices – the Parks and Recreation Department and Community Relations Coordinator have already moved.

The Parks and Recreation Department staff has moved from the 2nd floor of the Government Center to the Community Activity Center located at 205 E. Ft. Dade Avenue in Brooksville.

The Community Relations Coordinator's Office is now located on the 4th floor of the Government Center within the Office of Management and Budget (Room 464).

Beginning Monday, June 8th, County Commissioners' offices will be relocated from the 4th floor of the Government Center to the following locations:

During the week of June 15, the County Administrator and staff will move from 4th floor of the Government Center to the 2nd floor – Room 260 – formerly Parks & Recreation Department

Note: The County Administrator's Office will be closed on Monday, June 15th only, in order to complete the move.

The telephone number for the County Commissioners and County Administrator will remain the same – 754-4002. All telephone numbers for the affected offices will remain the same.

By the end of November, we expect the relocation schedule to be complete. As a result of these changes, the office of Alvin Mazourek, Property Appraiser, and Clerk of Court Karen Nicolai's Recording Office will discontinue occupying leased space, resulting in a savings of \$250,000 over the next five years.

The County will provide periodic updates on the process of the ongoing changes until the schedule is completed. The updates will be published as media releases as well as posted on the County's website at www.hernandocounty.us
