BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE (BPAC)

The Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) was established to provide a continuing forum with which to analyze and promote bicycle and pedestrian issues. As an integral part of the multi-modal transportation planning process, the BPAC reviews and updates changes to the transportation enhancement priority process and forwards these recommendations to the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO). The BPAC meets in April and October on the third Wednesday of the month, beginning at 5:30 p.m. Additional meetings are held as needed.

CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE (CAC)

The Citizen's Advisory Committee (CAC) provides a formal framework for continuing public input on the Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP), as well as other elements of the transportation planning process. It serves to evaluate and propose solutions from a citizen's perspective concerning alternative transportation proposals and critical issues, while providing the knowledge gained through the CAC into local citizen group discussions and meetings. The CAC meets on a monthly basis (or as determined by the MPO) on Tuesdays, beginning at 4:00 p.m.

TRANSPORTATION DISADVANTAGED LOCAL COORDINATING BOARD (TDLCB)

The Transportation Disadvantaged Local Coordinating Board (TDLCB) serves to identify local service needs and provide information, advice, and direction to the Community Transportation Coordinator ("CTC") on the coordination of services to be provided to the transportation disadvantaged within Hernando County, through the Florida Coordinated Transportation System ("FCTS"), in accordance with § 427.0157, F.S., and Rule 41-2.012, F.A.C. The TDLCB meets quarterly on the fourth Wednesday of the month, beginning at 10:00 a.m.
