

**REPAIR OF DAMAGE TO HERNANDO COUNTY
UTILITIES DEPARTMENT PROPERTY
POLICY NUMBER 23-03**

PURPOSE:

To ensure uniformity when charging organizations, individuals, firms, etc., for repairing damage to Hernando County Utilities Department's property.

POLICY:

It is the policy of Hernando County to charge all persons, firms, or associations who damage Hernando County Utilities Department's property, including but not limited to, water lines, sewer lines, valve boxes, manholes, meters, meter boxes, water and wastewater plants, lift stations, fire hydrants, vehicles, construction equipment, wells, and buildings per the following schedule:

Boring Missile	Per Hour	\$14.00
Quick-Cut Saw w/blade	Per Hour	\$ 8.00
Vacuum Truck	Per Hour	\$47.50
Boom Truck	Per Hour	\$48.00
Tanker Truck	Per Gallon	\$.10
Sewer Video Insp. Trailer	Per Linear Foot	\$.80
Compactor	Per Hour	\$ 8.00
Sewer Rodding Machine	Per Hour	\$ 8.00

<u>MATERIAL:</u>	<u>METHOD OF CHARGING:</u>	<u>RATE:</u>
Water Loss	Per 100 Gallons	\$.20
Actual Materials	Actual cost plus 25%	\$ Cost +25%

<u>LABOR:</u>	<u>METHOD OF CHARGING:</u>	<u>RATE:</u>
Supervisors	Actual hourly pay + 25%	\$ cost + 25%
Hourly Workers	Flat Rate/Worker/Hour	\$30/hr
Mobilization*	Flat Rate/Vehicle/Event	\$35/Vehicle

*Includes service trucks, vans, pick-ups, dump trucks, transport trailers, cars & all pieces of heavy equipment.

This policy shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
