Save Water—Indoors!

2007 Low Flow Toilet Replacement Program

In an effort to further promote water conservation in Hernando County homes, HCUD is offering as much as a \$200 (\$100 per toilet replaced) water bill credit for replacing older toilets (high gallon per flush) with new water efficient toilets (1.6 gallon per flush). The requirements to participate in this water conservation program are: you must be a Hernando County Utilities Department water or water/sewer customer, **the home must be older than 1994**, and the new water efficient toilet **must be installed by one of the participating plumbing contractors**.

Save Water—Outdoors!

2007 Rain Sensor Installation Program

This water conservation incentive program promotes residential outdoor water conservation by offering a \$50 water bill credit for customers who have a rain sensor installed to their irrigation system. To participate in the 2007 Rain Sensor Installation Program, participants must be a Hernando County Utilities Department water or water/sewer customer who irrigates with county supplied water, **the home must be older than 2001**, and the new rain sensor **must be installed by one of the participating irrigation contractors**.

Irrigation Evaluation and Audit Program!

In an effort to promote proper irrigation practices, HCUD and the Southwest Florida Water Management District's, Coastal Rivers and Withlacoochee River Basin Boards have implemented a project called the Irrigation Evaluation and Audit Program. Customers who use HCUD provided water to irrigate their lawns may be eligible for this program. The Hernando County Irrigation Evaluation and Audit Program includes an evaluation of the customer's irrigation system by an irrigation contractor. At the conclusion of the evaluation the customer will be given suggestions for changes to their irrigation system that will promote water conservation and will be given helpful conservation educational materials.
