

ORDINANCE NO. HCW&SD 87-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING HERNANDO COUNTY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT ORDINANCE NO. 80-1, KNOWN AS THE UTILITIES RATE ORDINANCE, AND AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 86-1; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 5, SCHEDULE OF DEPOSITS; SECTION 6, HOOK-UP CHARGE: WATER AND WASTEWATER; SECTION 10, WATER - TEMPORARY SERVICE; AND SECTION 15, RATES; TO PROVIDE THAT RATES MAY BE AMENDED BY RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD; TO AMEND FEES FOR SECTION 5, SCHEDULE OF DEPOSITS, AND SECTION 15, RATES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE HERNANDO COUNTY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. AMENDMENT. Section 5 of Hernando County Water and Sewer District Ordinance No. 80-1 is hereby amended in its entirety to read:

"SECTION 5. SCHEDULE OF DEPOSITS.

- A.. Schedule of deposits for water and/or sewer service shall be hereafter known as "utility deposits" and shall be required prior to service connection on all buildings for residential, commercial or industrial purposes.
- B. Commercial users, including but not limited to multiple habitants under a master meter; service stations; drugstores; cafeterias and restaurants; industrial users; any other commercial users; and residential users shall pay a utilities deposit which will be estimated as the equivalent of two months water and sewage charge.
- C. Utility deposits are to be established by and in the future may be amended by resolution of the Hernando County Water and Sewer District Board."

SECTION II. AMENDMENT. Section 6 of Hernando County Water and Sewer District Ordinance No. 80-1 is hereby amended in its entirety to read:

"SECTION 6. HOOK-UP CHARGES: WATER AND SEWER.

- A. Water Hook-up and Tap-in Fee - Charges for tapping water mains for each tap shall be sufficient to cover the costs of labor and materials, including, but not limited to the costs of the meter, meter boxes, corporation stop, valves, and appurtenances thereof.
- B. Water Turn-on Fee - When water service has been cut off or discontinued for non-payment of current bills or for water service which has been discontinued at a customers request, a water turn-on fee will be charged for the costs of restoring service.
- C. Damage or Replacement Charge - Where meters or appurtenances are broken or damaged by the negligence of the owners, tenants, or occupants of the premises, the cost of repair or replacement shall be paid by the customer; and if the cost of repair or replacement is not paid upon submission of a bill for charges, the water supply shall be turned off and shall not be turned on again until payment of such amount due is made.
- D. Sewer Hook-Up Fee - A sewer hook-up fee will be charged per connection based on an Equivalent Residential Unit (ERU) which is defined to be 200 gallons per day flow.
- E. Water hook-up and tap-in fees, water turn-on fees, damage or replacement charges, and sewer hook-up fees are to be established by and in the future amended by resolution of the Hernando County Water and Sewer District Board."

SECTION III. AMENDMENT. Section 10 of Hernando County Water and Sewer District Ordinance No. 80-1 is hereby amended in its entirety to read:

"SECTION 10. WATER - TEMPORARY SERVICE.

- A. Temporary service, such as service for circuses, fairs, carnivals, construction work and the like, shall be rendered upon written application and payment of applicable fees.

B. Rates for temporary water service are to be established by and in the future amended by resolution of the Hernando County Water and Sewer District Board."

SECTION IV. REPEAL. Hernando County Water and Sewer District Ordinance Number 86-1 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION V. AMENDMENT. Section 15 of Hernando County Water and Sewer District Ordinance Number 80-1 is hereby amended in its entirety to read:

"SECTION 15. RATES. - Service rates for water and sewer services shall be established by and in the future may be amended by resolution of the Hernando County Water and Sewer District Board."

SECTION VI. SEVERABILITY. If any section, part of section, paragraph, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance is declared invalid, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected.

SECTION VII. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

RESOLUTION NO. HCW&SD 87-2

WHEREAS, the Hernando County Water and Sewer District Board provides water and sewer service to customers of the Hernando County Water and Sewer District and is empowered to establish rates and service fees for usage of its water and sewer systems; and

WHEREAS, the Hernando County Water and Sewer District Board has established the Water and Sewer District as a separate enterprise fund and desires that revenue be sufficient to offset operation and maintenance expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Hernando County Water and Sewer District Board desires to establish equitable rates and service fees for its customers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HERNANDO COUNTY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Utility deposits for water and sewer service shall be as follows:

- (1) Habitation, separate habitation -
 - Water or sewer only - \$35.00
 - Water and sewer - \$60.00

- (2) Commercial users, including but not limited to multiple habitans under a master meter; service stations; drugstores; cafeterias and restaurants; industrial users; and any other commercial users shall pay a deposit which will be estimated as the equivalent of two (2) months water and sewage charge, such estimate to be determined by the Utilities Department, a minimum of \$35 for water or sewer service and \$60 for water and sewer service.

SECTION 2. HOOK-UP CHARGE: WATER AND SEWER

A. Water Hook-up and Tap-in Fee

- (1) Charges for tapping water mains for each tap shall be the costs of labor and materials, including, but not limited to the costs of the meter, meter boxes, corporation stop,

valves, and appurtenance thereof but with a minimum charge of the following:

	<u>MINIMUM CHARGE</u>
5/8" X 3/4" Regular house meters	\$ 150.00
1" Water meter	\$ 400.00
1½" Water meter	\$ 500.00
2" Water meter	\$ 650.00
2" Compound meter for motels, hospitals, and apartments	\$ 900.00
3" Compound meters for motels, hospitals, apartments and schools	\$ 1,700.00
4" Compound meters for motels, hospitals, apartments and schools	\$ 2,450.00
6" Compound meters for motels, hospitals, apartments and schools	\$ 3,850.00

(There will be additional charges where any State Road will be crossed, depending on the size of the meter).

B. Water Turn-on Fee

- (1) During department office hours \$17.50
- (2) After department office hours,
week-ends and holidays \$35.00

C. Sewer Hook-up Fee

\$75 per habitation or equivalent residential unit (ERU)

SECTION 3. WATER, TEMPORARY SERVICE

\$50 nonrefundable service charge and \$1.00 per thousand gallons of water used.

SECTION 4. RATES

The following schedule of rates shall apply to services rendered by the District monthly when such services are available. Said monthly rates are as follows:

A. RESIDENTIAL RATE STRUCTURE:

Water: \$ 8.00 for 3,000 gallons

\$ 1.00 for each 1,000 gallons thereafter

Sewer: \$ 6.50 per unit and \$2.25 for each 1,000 gallons
of water used up to a maximum of 8,000 gallons.

Turn on fee: \$17.50

B. COMMERCIAL RATE STRUCTURE:

5/8" x 3/4" water meter	Water: \$ 7.50 base rate and \$1.10 for each 1,000 gallons of water used
	Sewer: \$ 7.50 base rate and \$2.25 for each 1,000 gallons of water used
1" water meter	Water: \$ 16.50 base rate and \$1.10 for each 1,000 gallons of water used
	Sewer: \$ 20.00 base rate and \$2.25 for each 1,000 gallons of water used
1 1/2" or 1 1/2" water meter	Water: \$ 38.00 base rate and \$1.10 for each 1,000 gallons of water used
	Sewer: \$ 50.00 base rate and \$2.25 for each 1,000 gallons of water used
2" water meter	Water: \$ 54.00 base rate and \$1.10 for each 1,000 gallons of water used
	Sewer: \$ 100.00 base rate and \$2.25 for each 1,000 gallons of water used
3" water meter	Water: \$ 108.00 base rate and \$1.10 for each 1,000 gallons of water used
	Sewer: \$ 200.00 base rate and \$2.25 for each 1,000 gallons of water used
4" water meter	Water: \$ 162.50 base rate and \$1.10 for each 1,000 gallons of water used
	Sewer: \$ 300.00 base rate and \$2.25 for each 1,000 gallons of water used
6" water meter	Water: \$ 540.00 base rate and \$1.10 for each 1,000 gallons of water used

	Sewer: \$ 900.00 base rate and \$2.25
	for each 1,000 gallons of

8" water meter	Water: \$ 650.00 base rate and \$1.10
	for each 1,000 gallons of
	water used
	Sewer: \$1,090.00 base rate and \$2.25
	for each 1,000 gallons of
	water used
Turn on fee:	\$17.50

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
