YOU CAN RECYCLE THESE ITEMS

PAPER:

- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Telephone Books
- Paper Bags



Place in "NEWSPAPER" bin

TIN (STEEL) CANS:

Rinse Cans, Labels
DON'T need to be
removed.

If a separate bin is not
available, please place in
the "PLASTICS" bin.

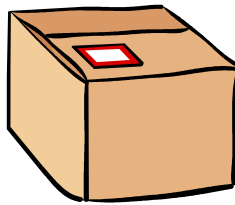


CARDBOARD:

Please flatten all boxes

- Corrugated
- Cereal Boxes
- Soda Boxes
- Beer Boxes
- Cracker Boxes

If a cardboard bin is
not available,
please place the
cardboard in the
"NEWSPAPER" bin.



PLASTIC # 1 & # 2 ONLY:



- Milk
- Soda
- Water
- Detergent Bottles,
etc.



Please Rinse Bottles !!!

Turn the bottle over, and look for the
recycled arrow triangle with a number in
it. If the number is a #1 or #2, the item is
acceptable. Please remove the plastic
lids!

Exception: Do NOT place motor oil
containers into the "PLASTICS" bin!!!
One partial can of oil WILL contaminate
the WHOLE bin of plastics.

ALUMINUM:

Rinse out beverage and food
cans. If a separate bin is not
available, please place in the
"PLASTICS" bin.



GLASS:

Glass bottles are accepted at some
locations.

SPECIAL NOTE:

We do not recycle plastic grocery bags.
Most grocery stores have recycle bins for
these items. Bins can usually be found in
the front of their businesses.

The following items are NOT accepted at
the recycling drop off locations. Please
contact the Solid Waste & Recycling
Facility of disposal.

- Small Appliances
- Chemicals
- Clothing
- Cookware
- Dishes
- Furniture
- Garbage Bags
- Light bulbs
- Medicine Bottles
- Mirrors
- Paint
- Pesticides
- Styrofoam
- Trash
- Toys
- Yard Debris
