

## Curbside Recycling Program

If you currently subscribe to curbside trash service through Republic Services, once per week curbside Recycling is included in your service *at no additional cost.*

**To get started...** with curbside recycling please call Republic Services at (800) 282-9820 to have your *free* bins delivered and determine your recycling pickup day.

**On your pickup day...** Place all of your paper and cardboard in one container and aluminum, tin, and plastics in the second container. Place the containers curbside before 6 a.m. on your service day.

Curbside recycling is a great opportunity to help yourself, your community and the environment.

**You can Recycle these items from the convenience of your curb:**

### **PAPER:**

- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Paper Bags
- Office Paper
- Junk mail
- Telephone Books



### **CARDBOARD:**

- Corrugated
- Cereal Boxes
- Cracker Boxes
- Soda and Beer Boxes



Please flatten boxes, remove any inner packing material and do NOT recycle cardboard contaminated with food (ie. Dirty Pizza boxes). Large boxes should be cut down to 3' X 3'

**ALUMINUM:** Please rinse all beverage and food cans



**TIN (STEEL) CANS:** Please rinse all beverage and food cans. Labels DO NOT need to be removed.



### **PLASTICS #1-7 ONLY:**

- Milk, Soda and Water Bottles
- Food containers such as cooking oil and salad dressings
- Personal care products like shampoo and lotion bottles
- Cleaning products such as laundry detergent and window cleaner



To determine if a plastic container is accepted look for the recycled arrow triangle, usually on the bottom of the container. If the number is 1-7 the item is generally acceptable, however we cannot accept plastic bags or film.

**EXCEPTION:** No motor oil or other automotive lubricant containers. One partial can of oil will contaminate the **WHOLE** bin of plastics.

## ITEMS NOT RECYCLED CURBSIDE

The following items are not recycled curbside but may be taken to an appropriate disposal or recycling location. Please call Hernando County Solid Waste (352) 754-4112 or visit our website at <http://www.hernandocounty.us> for more information on recycling these items and for a list of drop off locations.

- Glass, Light bulbs, Mirrors
- Chemicals, Pesticides, Paint
- Styrofoam, packing material
- Medicine or medicine bottles
- Toys, Clothing
- Cookware and Dishes
- Foam: pillows, carpet padding
- Small appliances / electronics
- Trash
- Scrap Metal
- Yard Waste (a separate yard waste collection day is also included in your service. Please call for information)
- Plastic grocery bags (these are accepted at most grocery stores – look for the bins in the front of their stores)
