



Resident Drop Off

Residents receive **FREE DROP OFF** of up to 2,000 pounds of household garbage and lawn trimmings per year!

Eligibility

Residents must own or live in home with a solid waste disposal assessment on the annual property taxes and bring material in themselves. Proof of Residency required.

Accepted at All Locations

Included in 2,000 pound Allowance

- Recycling: Paper, cardboard, rigid plastic containers, aluminum, tin. NO plastic bags!
- Paint and used motor oil (5 gal per month)
- fluorescent bulbs (up to 4 ft), PCB ballasts
- Automotive and rechargeable batteries
- Sharps and unwanted medications.
- Yard Waste: Small quantities of trimmings and grass clippings
- Household Trash: Kitchen waste, packaging, clothing and indoor furniture
- Syringes, Lancets, Non-Narcotic Medication
- Appliances
- Metal (Free of gas and oil): Bicycles, grills, lawnmowers, fencing, shelving, tin roofing

Accepted at Main Landfill Only Tipping Fees Charged

- Trees, stumps, large branches and land clearing debris
- Outdoor Trash and Furniture
- Construction Debris
- Household Hazardous Waste including cleaning products, pesticides, pool chemicals, solvents and automotive fluids are accepted free of charge



Commercial Drop Off

Commercial waste must be taken to the Northwest Solid Waste Management Facility (Main Landfill) where appropriate tipping fees will be charged.



Curbside Trash

Do NOT Mix with Recycling or Yard Waste

- Collected twice per week
- No commercial or business waste

Set Out Placement

- Waste must be inside provided blue container with lid closed
- Place at curb with handles away from road, clear of obstacles and overhead obstructions
- Place within 3 feet of road, but not in the road
- Set out before 6 am on service days, no earlier than 6 pm the night before
- Remove containers by end of day

Cleanliness

- BAG trash to prevent scattering
- Remove trash every 7 days
- Keep set out area clean
- Hauler not responsible for spills
- Customer responsible for keeping container clean and sanitary
- Hauler repairs normal wear and tear such as cracks, broken lid. For service call (352) 540-6457

Community Stops

- Only use YOUR assigned cart
- Address stickers may be put on cart



Curbside Recycling

Do NOT Mix with Trash

Pickup is NOT automatic. Call (352) 540-6457 to start recycling today!

- Collected once per week
- One set of bins provided by hauler. Additional containers of a like size and style can be used if needed
- Bins are approximately 18-20 gallons in size and open top
- All recycled items must fit into bins
- Must be free of food, plastic bags and trash. NO GLASS
- Mixed or contaminated recycling will NOT be collected
- Set out before 6 am on collection day. Remove bins by end of day

Recycling must be sorted

One Bin for Paper/Cardboard

Magazines, newspapers, office paper, junk mail, cereal and soda boxes, pizza boxes, shredded paper (in paper bags, not loose) and cardboard (under 3' X 3', flattened and fitting inside bin).

One Bin For Plastic, Aluminum, Tin

Aluminum and tin (steel) cans, rigid plastic containers, milk, soda, water, cooking oil, salad dressing, shampoo, and laundry detergent. Chemical containers must be empty and rinsed.



Curbside Yard Waste

Do NOT Mix with Trash


- Collected once per week
- Do NOT use the blue trash cart
- Covered trash cans, brown paper bags or bundles are preferred
- Loose yard waste or yard waste mixed with trash is not collected
- No yard waste generated by landscapers or other professionals

Size and Weight Limits

- Up to 12 containers, bags or TIED bundles up to 50 pounds each
- Maximum weight: 50 pounds each
- Maximum container size: 45 gallons
- Bundles must be under 4 feet long and tied
- Branches must be less than 4 inches in diameter and 4 feet in length
- Live Christmas trees may be disposed of if cut to under 4-foot lengths and cleaned of all decorations and tinsel

Keep it Clean

- Yard Waste is recycled and must be kept free of trash, plastic bags, rocks, flower pots and non-vegetative debris



Bulk Pickups

- Four Bulk items INCLUDED with trash service. Additional items with pre-payment of fee
- Bulk waste includes furniture, appliances and other large items that will not fit inside the container
- NO items that use gas or freon
- CALL to schedule and for instructions

General Information

Excess Trash

- Contact hauler for larger quantities that will not fit in cart. Additional fees may apply
- Drop off options are also available (see other side of brochure)

Set Out Times

- Set out before 6 am on designated days, no earlier than 6 pm the night before. Remove containers by end of day
